

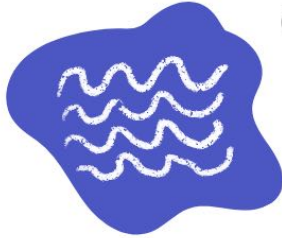
# Poetry Prompts!

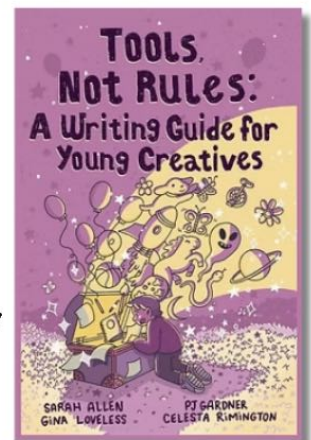
## Home Sweet Home
